Candidates for Partisan Offices

Pursuant to the court order, the Green Party of California must notify the Secretary of State by the close of business on February 18, 1992, as to which partisan offices the Party will be contesting at the June Primary. Until advised to the contrary, <u>you should</u> <u>continue to issue and receive for filing declarations of intention and nomination</u> <u>documents for all partisan offices.</u> However, only those declarations and documents that are determined to relate to contested offices shall be given effect. We will advise you of those on February 19, 1992. We are in the process of determining the number of in-lieu signatures required. We will advise you of our calculations when they have been completed.

None of the Above

In those races wherein the Green Party of California decides to run candidates, you must include "None of the Above" on the ballot. If "None of the Above" receives a plurality of the votes cast, then there will be no "nominee" of the party for that race. Please note that "None of the Above" must be at the bottom of the list of candidates. <u>It does not rotate</u>. (We are aware that this may create computer programming problems. We are prepared to work with you on options to minimize them.)
